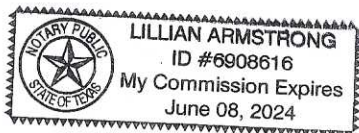

Election Day Voting Hours

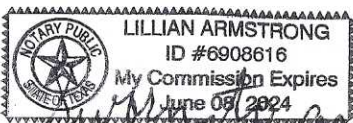
May 4, 2024 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Copy of order shall serve as a writ of election and deliver to appoint Presiding Judge for said Election



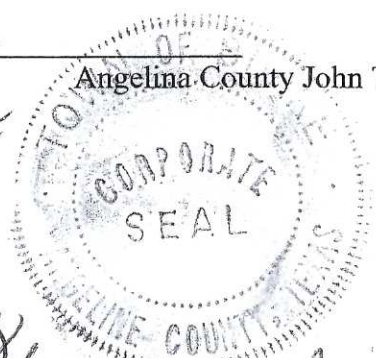

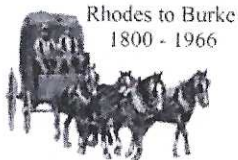
