The general election shall be held on the dates as follows, all qualified voters of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

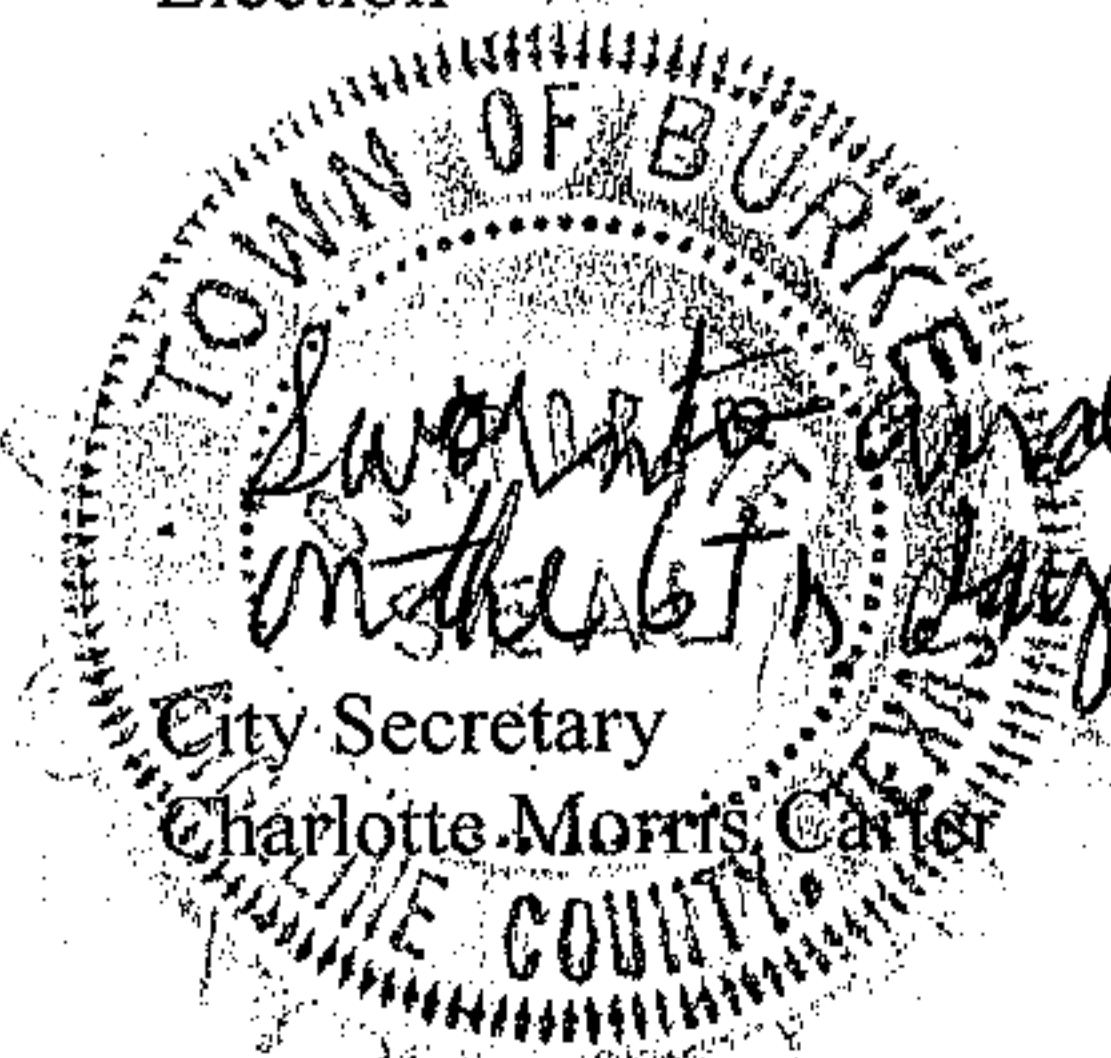
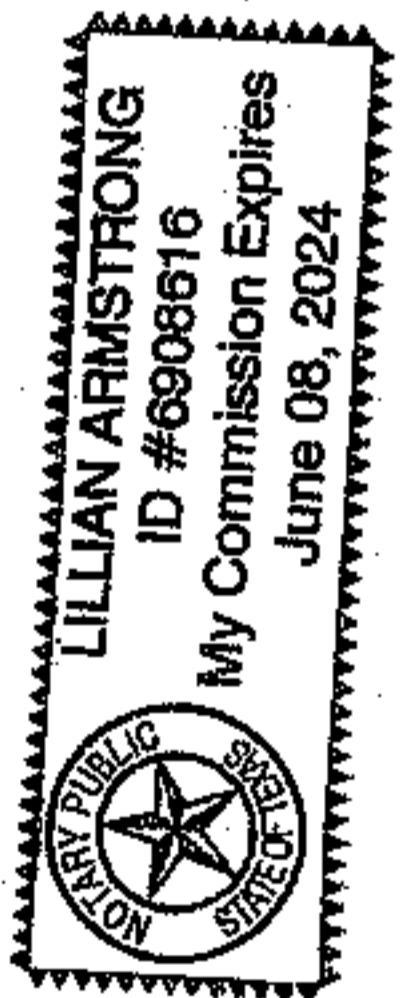
