Auditor's Comments

Agent McKinney conducted a full licensing audit on two licensees' files. He contacted Constable Thomas Selman who confirmed the condensed summary was correct. The "Racial Profiling Report" for 2015 has been filed. The RPR for 2012, 2013, and 2014 were filed as required. Changes to the F5R and the "My TCOLE Account" were discussed. Constable's continuing education, officer training for the current two year unit, the background and personal history statement, and the law enforcement agency checklist were also discussed. No deficiencies were noted. There were no "Other" pay status appointments.

(The last audit was conducted on 08-24-11. It was a partial audit and there were no deficiencies noted.)

The preliminary report was signed by and emailed to Constable Selman at his personal email. The county email server was not operational.
